

Specific directions for NPC- installation to Dresser / Wayne
(Interface ISM-Nucleus 8 und 9)

For the receipt interface ISM-Nucleus 8 and 9, the booking procedures of a point-of-sale are supported by the **NPC**. That is why each point-of-sale requires a module. These data are to be made available at each cash register computer system via a separate COM port.

Note: On the ISM Nucleus 9, the data are not sent out until the receipt is completed!!

This software is universal, i.e. it is not necessary for different software to be installed for version 8 or 9; the same applies to its use at different point-of-sale locations!

IMPORTANT:

The data format of the interface of the point-of-sale system should be set to **9600 baud, 8 bit, no parity**. All original data of the booking procedures that also appear on the cash-register control monitor are displayed.

To program the **NPC**, the configuration file **DrWayn_8+9.npc** is to be used. This file accepts the data of all Dresser Wayne- cash points 1-4. During this, all actions on the point-of-sale - as long as they are sent by the point-of-sale system - are supported. Since no other points-of-sale are connected to the system, there are no possible information from other cash points.
